First steps

First steps: JGU IDs app

- **Install the app “JGU Ausweise” (JGU IDs)**
 - If you log into the app with your student account, you can use the app as your ticket for public transportation.



First steps: Uni Mainz app

- **Install the app “Uni Mainz”** → If you log into the app with your student account, you can check the daily menus in the cafeterias on campus, have a look at your classes for the day, find buildings and rooms on a map, and much more.



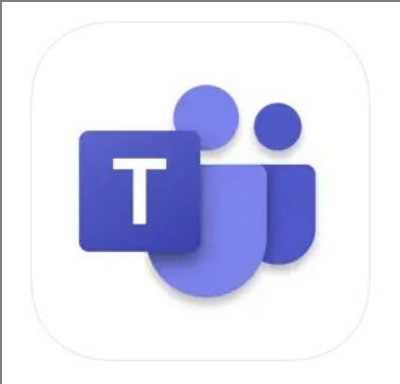
First steps: Studierendenwerk app

- Install the app “StW-Mainz@myAuthent” → You can use this app to pay for your meals in the cafeterias.
- Please note that you cannot pay in cash or with your debit card/credit card.



First steps: Microsoft Teams app

- **Download the app “Microsoft Teams”**
 - Log in with your JGU student ID and password
 - You can use the app to get in touch with your professors, instructors and other students at JGU – just search for their name or email address



First steps: check your JGU email account

- Go to mail.uni-mainz.de
 - Log in with your JGU student ID
 - Please check your university email account regularly (ideally daily)
 - Please use your university email account when you send emails to your instructors.

Frequently asked questions

Erasmus students

Q: How many classes can I choose?

A:

- If you are coming to Mainz **on an exchange with the Department of English and Linguistics**, you can select *all* your credits from the Department's teaching programme.
- Note, however, that you can choose **a maximum of 30 points per semester**.

Erasmus students and Freemovers

Q: How many classes can I choose?

A:

- If you are coming to Mainz **on an exchange with any other department** (e.g. Philosophy, Economics, Translation and Interpreting, etc.), you can select **a maximum of 15 credits** from classes offered by the Department of English and Linguistics.

Erasmus students and Freemovers

Q: Can the number of credits I get for a class be changed?

A: Every type of class is given a set value of credits. This reflects the amount of work you will be expected to invest in the respective class and is **not negotiable.**

Q: Do I have to take the same exam as the German students?

A: There may be some flexibility in the form of assessment expected of you in each individual class. Please speak to your instructor **at the beginning of term if you would like to ask if alternative forms of assessment are available.**

Erasmus students and Freemovers

Q: Can I expect the same classes to be taught each semester?

A: The topics of lectures as well as literature and linguistics classes **will change each semester.**

You can only expect classes of the “Übungen” (exercises) type to be the same each semester.

A: Type 1 - Übungen

- **Integrated Language Skills [grammar] 4 ECTS**
- **Written English [essay writing] 4 ECTS**
- **Translation Skills [translation German – English] 4 ECTS**
- **Spoken English [phonetics] 4 ECTS**
- **Cultural Studies I [history] 4 ECTS**
- **Cultural Studies II [recent history/contemporary society] 4 ECTS**
- **Cultural Studies III/IV [specific focus] 4 ECTS**

A: Type 2 – Topical classes

- **Proseminar [Literature, Linguistics, TEFL, years one and two] 6 ECTS**
- **Seminar [Literature, Linguistics, TEFL, year three and higher] 8 ECTS**
- **Vorlesung/Lecture [with exam and grade] 2 ECTS**

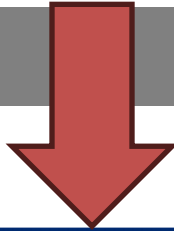



If the course, including the written examination, was not completed in a previous semester, we strongly recommend attending the course again in full (regular and active participation and written examination).

Contents:

The creation and development of the United States depended on choices of historical actors and specific circumstances. It requires historical explanations, some of which this introductory survey course offers. It will introduce you to the major cultural, social, and political developments in American history from the beginnings of European colonization to the Civil War (ca. 1500 to ca. 1860s). Using the tools of historians, our textbook, and a variety of primary sources, you will historicize such ideas as liberty, equality, and property. We will especially explore the contexts in which specific ideas of race and gender emerged, how these ideas changed over time, and how they were shaped by and in turn shaped American social and political structures.



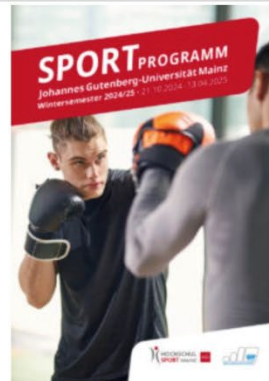
